Regional Song learning session March 21, 2015. There were members from all four choruses in Calgary and a number from Southern Accord in Lethbridge. Some Red Deer gals were coming but we ended up with dense fog and multiple accidents on the northern highway and they were not able to attend.

I was able to speak to the group and connect to our core values, collaboration, and the Fund. Mary Hager lead the session, Maja from Chinook Winds did the vocal warm up, a Rhythm member did physical warm up, and section leaders from Rhythm did the section rehearsals. Shamelessly, we had a bake sale table and water for sale, too to help fund our international journey. And then Susan McLean directed How We Sang.

Some comments below, but what I got out of the day was, obviously, learning of the two new regional songs and a sense of unity in a shared goal. Other learnings and benefits were experiencing song learning at a higher level, and in a larger chorus situation for many attendees.

One attendee was an assistant director who is charged with teaching one of the songs to her Chorus, she gained greater insight into what timing and learning issues needed to be addressed.

All in all, we were very happy with the turnout and the results. Just an FYI, Hooked on a Feeling was very hard to work as the leads had not "recognized" note differences from the pop version of the song. Hope that the learning session will send them back to the learning tracks!


How would you like an opportunity to send your good competition vibes into the future and at the same time get recognition for sponsoring chorus medals for next year's competition.
